Ch 3 v21 - 26 sums up the message in Romans

21 But now the righteousness of God without the law is manifested, being witnessed by the law and the prophets;

22 Even the righteousness of God which is by faith of Jesus Christ unto all and upon all them that believe: for there is no difference: 23 For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;

24 Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus:

25 Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God; 26 To declare, I say, at this time his righteousness: that he might be just, and the justifier of him which believeth in Jesus.

V 1-5

Pauls sorrow of heart

V6-13 Israel, the children of promise / the children of the flesh Gods choice not dependant on works, but His own sovereign counsel

V 14-18 Sovereignty of God Mercy is the prerogative of God. Pharaoh given as an example. Note the times recorded in Exod where Pharaoh hardened first his own heart

V19 – 24 God's dealings vindicated. His Wrath, His Longsuffering and His Mercy

V25-29 The OT scriptures quoted to confirm Gods word which spoke of God calling the Gentiles as well as the Jews

 Note: Quotations from O.T.:- v 25 Hos 2.23 v26 Hos 1.10 v27 Isa 10.21-23. LXX v28

 Isa 28.22 v29 Isa 1.9

V30 -33 Righteousness is on the ground of faith alone. The Gentiles attain to righteousness by faith. Israel following after the law, fail to attain righteousness which is not by works but by faith.

4 Who are Israelites; to whom pertaineth the adoption, and the glory, and the covenants, and the giving of the law, and the service of God, and the promises;

Israelites Gen 32.28 linked with Jacob **Prince With God** v28 And he said, Thy name shall be called no more Jacob, but Israel: for as a **prince hast thou power with God** and with men, and hast prevailed.

Hos 12. 3 **Power with God** *v3 He took his brother by the heel in the womb, and by his strength he had power with God:*

Gal 6.16 **Israel of God** v16 And as many as walk according to this rule, peace be on them, and mercy, and upon the Israel of God.

"Hebrew" speaks of nationality, one of God's chosen people

"Jew" speaks of national distinction from the Gentiles

"Israel" speaks of a people having a distinct relationship with God

The Adoption

Exod 4.22 Thus saith the LORD, Israel is my son, even my firstborn:

Deut 7.6 For thou art an holy people unto the LORD thy God: the LORD thy God hath chosen thee to be a special people unto himself, above all people that are upon the face of the earth.

Amos 3.2 You only have I known of all the families of the earth:

The Election Of Israel Is Absolute And Eternal

Isa 66.22 *For as the new heavens and the new earth, which I will make, shall remain before me, saith the LORD, so shall your seed and your name remain.*

2) The Glory

Exod 21: 8 And let them make me a sanctuary; that **I may dwell among** *them.*

Exod 21:21,22 v21 *And thou shalt put the mercy seat above upon the ark; and in the ark thou shalt put the testimony that I shall give thee.* v22 *And there I will meet with thee, and* **I will commune with thee from above the mercy seat, from between the two cherubins which are upon the ark of the testimony,**

2Chron 5. 13,14 v13 It came even to pass, as the trumpeters and singers were as one, to make one sound to be heard in praising and thanking the LORD; and when they lifted up their voice with the trumpets and cymbals and instruments of musick, and praised the LORD, saying, For he is good; for his mercy endureth for ever: that then the house was filled with a cloud, even the house of the LORD; v14 So that the priests could not stand to minister by reason of the cloud: for the glory of the LORD had filled the house of God.

3) The Covenants.

Linked more with a promise than an agreement between two parties. See Gal 3.16-18 Promises made by God to the Patriarchs.

Abraham Gen 12. 1-3 $1 \, \P$ Now the LORD had said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee: 2 And I will make of thee a great nation, and I will bless thee, and make thy name great; and thou shalt be a blessing: 3 And I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee: and in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed.

Gen 15. 18 In the same day the LORD made a covenant with Abram, saying, Unto thy seed have I given this land, from the river of Egypt unto the great river, the river Euphrates:

Isaac Promise of Isaac Gen 18.10 *And he said, I will certainly return unto thee according to the time of life; and, lo, Sarah thy wife shall have a son. And Sarah heard it in the tent door, which was behind him.* **Isaac** Born in Gen 21

Gen 22. 15 -18 15 ¶ And the angel of the LORD called unto Abraham out of heaven the second time, 16 And said, By myself have I sworn, saith the LORD, for because thou hast done this thing, and hast not withheld thy son, thine only son: 17 That in blessing I will bless thee, and in multiplying I will multiply thy seed as the stars of the heaven, and as the sand which is upon the sea shore; and thy seed shall possess the gate of his enemies; 18 And in thy seed shall all the nations of the earth be blessed; because thou hast obeyed my voice.

Cp Eph 2.12 Gentiles strangers from the covenants of promise

4) **The Giving of the Law**.

There are over 600 Laws, Commandments, Statutes, Judgements, Testimonies, Precepts Etc associated with the law

5) The Service of God

This is the thought of worship connected with the tabernacle and temple cp Heb 9.1

- 6) The Promises.
- See Gal 3.16 This speaks of Gods promises first given to Abraham in Gen 12 1-3

7) The Fathers.

Abraham; Isaac and Jacob. Cp Heb 7. 14 For it is evident that our Lord sprang out of Juda;

V5 Whose are the fathers, and of whom as concerning the flesh Christ came,

The thought in '*of whom*' here is '*from whom* as concerning the flesh'. This teaches us that Christ sprang from the nation of Israel being born of the virgin Mary.

Ch 1.3 Concerning his Son Jesus Christ our Lord, which was made of the seed of David according to the flesh;

Jn1.14 And the Word **was made flesh**, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.

Heb 2.16 For verily he took not on him the nature of angels; but he took on him the seed of Abraham. 17 Wherefore in all things it behoved him to be made like unto his brethren, that he might be a merciful and faithful high priest in things pertaining to God, to make reconciliation for the sins of the people.

Matt 1.1 The book of the generation of Jesus Christ, the son of David, the son of Abraham

V5 cont. "who is over all, God blessed for ever. Amen. "

Ref Heb 1.8 But **unto the Son he saith**, **Thy throne**, **O God**, is for ever and ever: a sceptre of righteousness is the sceptre of thy kingdom. 9 Thou hast loved righteousness, and hated iniquity; therefore God, even thy God, hath anointed thee with the oil of gladness above thy fellows.

This seems a fitting testimony to the diety of Christ Lit the text reads 'the one being'

'over all' ref 1Cor 15 **27** For he hath put all things under his feet. But when he saith all things are put under him, it is manifest that he is excepted, which did put all things under him. 28 And when all things shall be subdued unto him, then shall the Son also himself be subject unto him that put all things under him, that God may be all in all.

Jn 1 1-3 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 2 The same was in the beginning with God. 3 All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made. Col 1 16 For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him: 17 And he is before all things, and by him all things consist.
