The following is set of notes from meetings held in the west End Gospel hall on Eph 6.

The purpose of this exercise is to show the might and power and pre-fall glory of the Devil as Lucifer the anointed cherub that covereth. We will also look at the names accorded him in the scriptures, some of his characteristics, comparisons made, some of his activities, and finally the protective measures provided and actions we can take.

Before the fall

Job 38:4 'Where wast thou when I laid the foundations of the earth? declare, if thou hast understanding. 5 Who hath laid the measures thereof, if thou knowest? or who hath stretched the line upon it? 6 Whereupon are the foundations thereof fastened? or who laid the corner stone thereof; 7 When the morning stars sang together, and all the sons of God shouted for joy? From this question in Job it is clear that Satan was present as one of the Sons of God at the creation of this earth.

Angelic beings

- Angels have different orders and it would appear that Satan as the annointed Cherub was of the highest.
- **<u>Cherubim:-</u>** They are standing on guard as it were at the gate of the garden in Genesis, and in Exod 25 over the mercy seat.
- <u>Seraphims:-</u> They are only found in Isa 6. Above the throne stood the seraphims: The word translated 'seraphim' is used of the fiery serpent in Num 21 v6 & 8 Deut 8 and Isa 14 and Isa 30. Only as Seraphims in Isa 6

Archangels - Michael and Gabriel.

- <u>Michael:- In</u> Jude 1:9 **Michael** the archangel, when contending with the devil Re 12: **Michael** and his angels fought against the dragon; Da 10:13 **Michael**, one of the chief princes, came to help me; Da 10:21 **Michael** your prince. Da 12:1 at that time shall **Michael** stand up, the great prince
- <u>Gabriel</u> Da 8:16 <u>Gabriel</u>, make this *man* to understand the vision. Da 9:21 the man <u>Gabriel</u>, whom I had seen in the vision Lu 1:19 I am <u>Gabriel</u>, that stand in the presence of God Lu 1:26 the angel <u>Gabriel</u> was sent from God
- <u>Angels</u>:- We have angels Ps 103:21 Bless ye the LORD, all *ye* his hosts; *ye* ministers <<u>08334></u> of his, that do his pleasure.
- We have ministers Ps 104:4 Who maketh his angels spirits; his ministers a flaming fire:
- <u>We have Principalities, powers etc.</u> Eph 1:21 Far above all <u>principality</u>, and <u>power</u>, and <u>might</u>, and <u>dominion</u>, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come:
- Col 1.16 For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether *they be* **thrones**, or **dominions**, or **principalities**, or **powers**: all things were created by him, and for him:
- **Four living creatures** Eze 1:5 Also out of the midst thereof *came* the likeness of <u>four living</u> <u>creatures</u>. And this *was* their appearance; they had the likeness of a man.
- **Four beasts** Re 4:8 And the four **beasts** had each of them six wings about *him*; and *they were* full of eyes within: and they rest not day and night, saying, Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, which was, and is, and is to come. 9 And when those **beasts** give glory and honour and thanks to him that sat on the throne, who liveth for ever and ever.

Michael in the Hebrew language means "Who is like unto God?" or "Who is equal to God?" St. Michael has been depicted from earliest Christian times as a commander, who holds in his right hand a spear with which he attacks Lucifer, Satan, and in his left hand a green palm branch. At the top of the spear there is a linen ribbon with a red cross. The Archangel Michael is especially considered to be the Guardian of the Orthodox Faith and a fighter against heresies.

- *Gabriel* means "Man of God" or "Might of God". He is the herald of the mysteries of God, especially the <u>Incarnation of God</u> and all other mysteries related to it. He is depicted as follows: In his right hand, he holds a lantern with a lighted taper inside, and in his left hand, a mirror of green <u>jasper</u>. The mirror signifies the wisdom of God as a hidden mystery.
- *Raphael* means "God's healing" or "God the Healer" (<u>Tobit</u> 3:17, 12:15). Raphael is depicted leading Tobit (who is carrying a fish caught in the <u>Tigris</u>) with his right hand, and holding a physician's alabaster jar in his left hand.
- *Uriel* means "Fire of God", or "Light of God" (III Esdras 3:1, 5:20). He is depicted holding a sword against the Persians in his right hand, and a fiery flame in his left.
- <u>Selaphiel</u> means "Intercessor of God" (III Esdras 5:16). He is depicted with his face and eyes lowered, holding his hands on his bosom in prayer.
- *Jegudiel* means "Glorifier of God". He is depicted bearing a golden wreath in his right hand and a triple-thonged whip in his left hand.
- *Barachiel* means "Blessing of God". He is depicted holding a white rose in his hand against his breast.
- (*Jeremiel* means "God's exaltation". He is venerated as an inspirer and awakener of exalted thoughts that raise a person toward God (III Ezra 4:36). As an *eighth*, he is sometimes included as archangel.)

Sons of God before God. Job clarifies Satan was counted as among the sons of God, this event after Satans fall.

Job 1.6 ¶ Now there was a day when the sons of God came to present themselves before the LORD, and Satan came also among them.

Beauty of Lucifer

<u>None of the following statements could really be construed as a man and must speak of Lucifer.</u>

Ezek 28:12 Son of man, take up a lamentation upon the king of Tyrus, and say unto him, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Thou sealest up the sum, full of wisdom, and perfect in beauty.

<u>Lucifer was a created creature and was associated with the throne of God, He was seen</u> to be glorious in apparel and Ezekiel stresses he was created.

Eze 28:13 Thou hast been in Eden the garden of God; every precious stone *was* thy covering, the sardius, topaz, and the diamond, the beryl, the onyx, and the jasper, the sapphire, the emerald, and the carbuncle, and gold: the workmanship of thy tabrets and of thy pipes was prepared in thee in the day that thou wast created.

Anointed cherub Again the singular glory of place and activity is displayed, The stones of fire may be before the thrones or the stars of the heavens. We are not told. The Holy mountain could be associated with Zion.

Eze 28:14 Thou *art* the anointed cherub that covereth; and I have set thee *so*: thou wast upon the holy mountain of God; thou hast walked up and down in the midst of the stones of fire.

<u>Iniquity found in Lucifer</u> <u>As the creation of God there was perfection seen in Lucifer,</u> <u>till iniquity was found in him</u>

Eze 28:15 Thou *wast* perfect in thy ways from the day that thou wast created, till iniquity was found in thee.

Condemnation

The sentence is passed, Lucifer is doomed, no longer free to move in the presence of <u>God.</u>

Eze 28:16 By the multitude of thy merchandise they have filled the midst of thee with violence, and thou hast sinned: therefore I will cast thee as profane out of the mountain of God: and I will destroy thee, O covering cherub, from the midst of the stones of fire.

Lucifer was occupied with self, his beauty and wisdom and his heart was lifted up

Eze 28:17 Thine heart was lifted up because of thy beauty, thou hast corrupted thy wisdom by reason of thy brightness: I will cast thee to the ground, I will lay thee before kings, that they may behold thee.

<u>Isa states the fall of Lucifer Son of the morning.</u> <u>Satans ambition was his downfall, He</u> was already, it would appear, higher than the other created beings, but he wanted a throne of his own, not willing to serve at the throne of God.

Isa 14.12 How art thou fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! how art thou cut down to the ground, which didst weaken the nations! 13 For thou hast said in thine heart, I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God: I will sit also upon the mount of the congregation, in the sides of the north: 14 I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the most High. 15 Yet thou shalt be brought down to hell, to the sides of the pit.

The Lord could be speaking of past events of future action against satan.

Lu 10:18 And he said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven.

This activity is surely a future event.Satan cast down he second time.

Re 12:7 And there was war in heaven: Michael and his angels fought against the dragon; and the dragon fought and his angels, Re 12:8 And prevailed not; neither was their place found any more in heaven. Re 12:9 And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceiveth the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him. Re 12:10 And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night.

Satan is cast into the abyss for 1000 years. He will be released.

Rev 20.1 ¶ And I saw an angel descending from the heaven, having the key of the abyss, and a great chain in his hand. 2 And he laid hold of the dragon, the ancient serpent who is *the* devil and Satan, and bound him a thousand years, 3 and cast him into the abyss, and shut *it* and sealed *it* over him, that he should not any more deceive the nations until the thousand years were completed; after these things he must be loosed for a little time.

This is the final battle and the end of Satan as we will see in Rev 20.10

Rev 20.7 And when the thousand years have been completed, Satan shall be loosed from his prison, 8 and shall go out to deceive the nations which *are* in the four corners of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to the war, whose number *is* as the sand of the sea. 9 And they went up on the breadth of the earth, and surrounded the camp of the saints and the beloved city: and fire came down *from God* out of the heaven and devoured them.

Here for the final time satan is cast down.

Rev 20.10 And the devil who deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where *are* both the beast and the false prophet; and they shall be tormented day and night for the ages of ages.

Michaels respect for the Devil

Jude 1:9 Yet Michael the archangel, when contending with the **<u>devil</u>** he disputed about the body of Moses, durst not bring against him a railing accusation, but said, The Lord rebuke thee.

Fallen Angels Judged

Satan entered Judas

Annanias heart filled with Satan

Oppressed of the Devil

Acts 10.38 How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the **devil**; for God was with him.

Peter speaking as Satan would speak

Job 1:9 Then <u>Satan</u> answered the LORD, and said, Doth Job fear God for nought?
- Job 1:12 And the LORD said unto **Satan**, Behold, all that he hath *is* in thy power; only upon himself put not forth thine hand. So **Satan** went forth from the presence of the LORD.
- Job 2:1 Again there was a day when the sons of God came to present themselves before the LORD, and **Satan** came also among them to present himself before the LORD. Job 2:2 And the LORD said unto **Satan**, From whence comest thou? And **Satan** answered the LORD, and said, From going to and fro in the earth, and from walking up and down in it. Job 2:3 And the LORD said unto **Satan**, Hast thou considered my servant Job, that *there is* none like him in the earth, a perfect and an upright man, one that feareth God, and escheweth evil? and still he holdeth fast his integrity, although thou movedst me against him, to destroy him without cause. Job 2:4 And **Satan** answered the LORD, and said, Skin for skin, yea, all that a man hath will he give for his life.
- Job 2:6 And the LORD said unto <u>Satan</u>, Behold, he *is* in thine hand; but save his life. Job 2:7 So went <u>Satan</u> forth from the presence of the LORD, and smote Job with sore boils from the sole of his foot unto his crown.
- Ps 109:6 Set thou a wicked man over him: and let **<u>Satan</u>** stand at his right hand.
- Zec 3:1 And he shewed me Joshua the high priest standing before the angel of the LORD, and **Satan** standing at his right hand to resist him.
- Zec 3:2 And the LORD said unto **<u>Satan</u>**, The LORD rebuke thee, O <u>**Satan**</u>; even the LORD that hath chosen Jerusalem rebuke thee: *is* not this a brand plucked out of the fire?
- Mt 4:10 Then saith Jesus unto him, Get thee hence, **Satan**: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve.
- Mt 12:26 And if **<u>Satan</u>** cast out **<u>Satan</u>**, he is divided against himself; how shall then his kingdom stand?
- Mt 16:23 But he turned, and said unto Peter, Get thee behind me, <u>Satan</u>: thou art an offence unto me: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but those that be of men.
- Mr 1:13 And he was there in the wilderness forty days, tempted of **Satan**; and was with the wild beasts; and the angels ministered unto him.
- Mr 3:23 And he called them *unto him*, and said unto them in parables, How can **Satan** cast out **Satan**?
- Mr 3:26 And if <u>Satan</u> rise up against himself, and be divided, he cannot stand, but hath an end.
- Mr 4:15 And these are they by the way side, where the word is sown; but when they have heard, **<u>Satan</u>** cometh immediately, and taketh away the word that was sown in their hearts.

- Mr 8:33 But when he had turned about and looked on his disciples, he rebuked Peter, saying, Get thee behind me, <u>Satan</u>: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but the things that be of men.
- Lu 4:8 And Jesus answered and said unto him, Get thee behind me, <u>Satan</u>: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve.
- Lu 10:18 And he said unto them, I beheld **<u>Satan</u>** as lightning fall from heaven.
- Lu 11:18 If <u>Satan</u> also be divided against himself, how shall his kingdom stand? because ye say that I cast out devils through Beelzebub.
- Lu 13:16 And ought not this woman, being a daughter of Abraham, whom <u>Satan</u> hath bound, lo, these eighteen years, be loosed from this bond on the sabbath day?
- Lu 22:3 Then entered **Satan** into Judas surnamed Iscariot, being of the number of the twelve.
- Lu 22:31 And the Lord said, Simon, Simon, behold, <u>Satan</u> hath desired *to have* you, that he may sift *you* as wheat:
- Joh 13:27 And after the sop **Satan** entered into him. Then said Jesus unto him, That thou doest, do quickly.
- Ac 5:3 But Peter said, Ananias, why hath **Satan** filled thine heart to lie to the Holy Ghost, and to keep back *part* of the price of the land?
- Ac 26:18 To open their eyes, *and* to turn *them* from darkness to light, and *from* the power of **Satan** unto God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in me.
- Ro 16:20 And the God of peace shall bruise **Satan** under your feet shortly. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ *be* with you. Amen.
- 1Co 5:5 To deliver such an one unto **Satan** for the destruction of the flesh, that the spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord Jesus.
- 1Co 7:5 Defraud ye not one the other, except *it be* with consent for a time, that ye may give yourselves to fasting and prayer; and come together again, that **Satan** tempt you not for your incontinency.
- 2Co 2:11 Lest Satan should get an advantage of us: for we are not ignorant of his devices.
- 2Co 11:14 And no marvel; for <u>Satan</u> himself is transformed into an angel of light.
- 2Co 12:7 And lest I should be exalted above measure through the abundance of the revelations, there was given to me a thorn in the flesh, the messenger of **Satan** to buffet me, lest I should be exalted above measure.
- 1Th 2:18 Wherefore we would have come unto you, even I Paul, once and again; but <u>Satan</u> hindered us.
- 2Th 2:9 *Even him,* whose coming is after the working of <u>Satan</u> with all power and signs and lying wonders,
- 1Ti 1:20 Of whom is Hymenaeus and Alexander; whom I have delivered unto <u>Satan</u>, that they may learn not to blaspheme.
- 1Ti 5:15 For some are already turned aside after **Satan**.
- Re 2:9 I know thy works, and tribulation, and poverty, (but thou art rich) and *I know* the blasphemy of them which say they are Jews, and are not, but *are* the synagogue of **Satan**.
- Re 2:13 I know thy works, and where thou dwellest, *even* where <u>Satan</u> 's seat *is*: and thou holdest fast my name, and hast not denied my faith, even in those days wherein Antipas *was* my faithful martyr, who was slain among you, where <u>Satan</u> dwelleth.
- Re 2:24 But unto you I say, and unto the rest in Thyatira, as many as have not this doctrine, and which have not known the depths of **Satan**, as they speak; I will put upon you none other burden.

- Re 3:9 Behold, I will make them of the synagogue of <u>Satan</u>, which say they are Jews, and are not, but do lie; behold, I will make them to come and worship before thy feet, and to know that I have loved thee.
- Re 12:9 And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and **Satan**, which deceiveth the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.
- Re 20:2 And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and **Satan**, and bound him a thousand years,
- Re 20:7 And when the thousand years are expired, Satan shall be loosed out of his prison,
- Re 9:11 And they had a king over them, *which is* the angel of the bottomless pit, whose name in the Hebrew tongue *is* Abaddon, but in the Greek tongue hath *his* name **Apollyon**.
- Mt 10:25 It is enough for the disciple that he be as his master, and the servant as his lord. If they have called the master of the house **<u>Beelzebub</u>**, how much more *shall they call* them of his household?
- Mt 12:24 But when the Pharisees heard *it*, they said, This *fellow* doth not cast out devils, but by **Beelzebub** the prince of the devils.
- Mt 12:27 And if I by **Beelzebub** cast out devils, by whom do your children cast *them* out? therefore they shall be your judges.
- Mr 3:22 And the scribes which came down from Jerusalem said, He hath **Beelzebub**, and by the prince of the devils casteth he out devils.
- Lu 11:15 But some of them said, He casteth out devils through **Beelzebub** the chief of the devils.
- Lu 11:18 If Satan also be divided against himself, how shall his kingdom stand? because ye say that I cast out devils through **Beelzebub**.
- Lu 11:19 And if I by **Beelzebub** cast out devils, by whom do your sons cast *them* out? therefore shall they be your judges.
- Ge 3:1 Now the <u>serpent</u> was more subtil than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said unto the woman, Yea, hath God said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden?
- Ge 3:2 And the woman said unto the **serpent**, We may eat of the fruit of the trees of the garden:
- Ge 3:4 And the **serpent** said unto the woman, Ye shall not surely die:
- Ge 3:13 And the LORD God said unto the woman, What *is* this *that* thou hast done? And the woman said, The **serpent** beguiled me, and I did eat.
- Ge 3:14 And the LORD God said unto the **serpent**, Because thou hast done this, thou *art* cursed above all cattle, and above every beast of the field; upon thy belly shalt thou go, and dust shalt thou eat all the days of thy life:
- Ge 49:17 Dan shall be a **<u>serpent</u>** by the way, an adder in the path, that biteth the horse heels, so that his rider shall fall backward.
- Ex 4:3 And he said, Cast it on the ground. And he cast it on the ground, and it became a <u>serpent</u>; and Moses fled from before it.
- Ex 7:9 When Pharaoh shall speak unto you, saying, Shew a miracle for you: then thou shalt say unto Aaron, Take thy rod, and cast *it* before Pharaoh, *and* it shall become a **serpent**.

- Ex 7:10 And Moses and Aaron went in unto Pharaoh, and they did so as the LORD had commanded: and Aaron cast down his rod before Pharaoh, and before his servants, and it became a **serpent**.
- Ex 7:15 Get thee unto Pharaoh in the morning; lo, he goeth out unto the water; and thou shalt stand by the river's brink against he come; and the rod which was turned to a **serpent** shalt thou take in thine hand.
- Nu 21:8 And the LORD said unto Moses, Make thee a fiery **serpent**, and set it upon a pole: and it shall come to pass, that every one that is bitten, when he looketh upon it, shall live.
- Nu 21:9 And Moses made a **<u>serpent</u>** of brass, and put it upon a pole, and it came to pass, that if a **<u>serpent</u>** had bitten any man, when he beheld the **<u>serpent</u>** of brass, he lived.
- 2Ki 18:4 He removed the high places, and brake the images, and cut down the groves, and brake in pieces the brasen **serpent** that Moses had made: for unto those days the children of Israel did burn incense to it: and he called it Nehushtan.
- Job 26:13 By his spirit he hath garnished the heavens; his hand hath formed the crooked **serpent**.
- Ps 58:4 Their poison *is* like the poison of a **serpent**: *they are* like the deaf adder *that* stoppeth her ear;
- Ps 140:3 They have sharpened their tongues like a **<u>serpent</u>**; adders' poison *is* under their lips. Selah.
- Pr 23:32 At the last it biteth like a **serpent**, and stingeth like an adder.
- Pr 30:19 The way of an eagle in the air; the way of a **serpent** upon a rock; the way of a ship in the midst of the sea; and the way of a man with a maid.
- Ec 10:8 He that diggeth a pit shall fall into it; and whoso breaketh an hedge, a **<u>serpent</u>** shall bite him.
- Ec 10:11 Surely the **serpent** will bite without enchantment; and a babbler is no better.
- Isa 14:29 Rejoice not thou, whole Palestina, because the rod of him that smote thee is broken: for out of the **serpent** 's root shall come forth a cockatrice, and his fruit *shall be* a fiery flying **serpent**.
- Isa 27:1 In that day the LORD with his sore and great and strong sword shall punish leviathan the piercing **serpent**, even leviathan that crooked **serpent**; and he shall slay the dragon that *is* in the sea.
- Isa 30:6 The burden of the beasts of the south: into the land of trouble and anguish, from whence *come* the young and old lion, the viper and fiery flying **serpent**, they will carry their riches upon the shoulders of young asses, and their treasures upon the bunches of camels, to a people *that* shall not profit *them*.
- Isa 65:25 The wolf and the lamb shall feed together, and the lion shall eat straw like the bullock: and dust *shall be* the **serpent** 's meat. They shall not hurt nor destroy in all my holy mountain, saith the LORD.
- Jer 46:22 The voice thereof shall go like a **serpent**; for they shall march with an army, and come against her with axes, as hewers of wood.
- Am 5:19 As if a man did flee from a lion, and a bear met him; or went into the house, and leaned his hand on the wall, and a **serpent** bit him.
- Am 9:3 And though they hide themselves in the top of Carmel, I will search and take them out thence; and though they be hid from my sight in the bottom of the sea, thence will I command the **serpent**, and he shall bite them:
- Mic 7:17 They shall lick the dust like a **<u>serpent</u>**, they shall move out of their holes like worms of the earth: they shall be afraid of the LORD our God, and shall fear because of thee.
- Mt 7:10 Or if he ask a fish, will he give him a serpent?

- Lu 11:11 If a son shall ask bread of any of you that is a father, will he give him a stone? or if *he ask* a fish, will he for a fish give him a **serpent**?
- Joh 3:14 And as Moses lifted up the **serpent** in the wilderness, even so must the Son of man be lifted up:
- 2Co 11:3 But I fear, lest by any means, as the **<u>serpent</u>** beguiled Eve through his subtilty, so your minds should be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ.
- Re 12:9 And the great dragon was cast out, that old **<u>serpent</u>**, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceiveth the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.
- Re 12:14 And to the woman were given two wings of a great eagle, that she might fly into the wilderness, into her place, where she is nourished for a time, and times, and half a time, from the face of the **serpent**.
- Re 12:15 And the **serpent** cast out of his mouth water as a flood after the woman, that he might cause her to be carried away of the flood.
- Re 20:2 And he laid hold on the dragon, that old **<u>serpent</u>**, which is the Devil, and Satan, and bound him a thousand years,
- 1Pe 5:8 Be sober, be vigilant; because your **adversary** <<u>476></u> the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:
