Concise dictionary

prognwaiv. A knowledge of persons and events before they exist. It is one of the divine attributes of God, by which persons were foreknown of Him and events determined. It is a capacity altogether beyond the mind of man to grasp

Isa 46.9 Remember the former things of old: for I am God, and there is none else; I am God, and there is none like me, 10 Declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient times the things that are not yet done, saying, My counsel shall stand, and I will do all my pleasure:

1Pet 1.20 The manifestation of the Lord Jesus in 1Pet 1.20 was foreknown by God.

Note:- The word translated *'foreordained'* should really be *'foreknown'*. Acts 2.23 The death of the Lord Jesus was foreknown by God.

Election - Divine Choice

lit. signifies "picked out, chosen. The word is used of both human and Divine choices. "The death of Christ was sufficient for all men, and is therefore effective in the case of the "elect," yet men are treated as responsible, being capable of the will and power to choose"

- 1) Election is according to the foreknowledge of God [1Pe 1:2]
- 2) Election is wholly of grace, apart from human merit *Ro 9: Rom11*.
- **3)** Election proceeds from the divine volition *Job 15:16*.
- Election is the sovereign act of God in grace whereby certain are chosen from among mankind for Himself. *Job 15:*

Predestination

If election deals with persons, then we find predestination deals with purpose.

Quote:- "Predestination is that effective exercise of the will of God by which things before determined by Him are brought to pass."

Schofield:- "The divine order is foreknowledge, election, predestination. That foreknowledge determines the election or choice is clear from #1Pe 1:2 and predestination is the bringing to pass of the election. "election looks back to foreknowledge; predestination forward to the destiny." But Scripture nowhere declares what it is in the divine foreknowledge which determines the divine election and predestination. The foreknown are elected, and the elect are predestinated, and this election is certain to every believer by the mere fact that he believes #1Th 1:4,5 "
